## GENERAL AND SPECIAL ELECTION, TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 1972

### INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER

- Move the Red Handle of the Curtain Lever to the right so far as it will go and leave it there, which will close the curtain and will unlock the machine for voting.
  - TO VOTE
    - You may vote a straight party ticket by pulling the lever of your party to the right and leaving it there.
 

OR
    - You may vote a split ticket by turning down the individual pointers over the name of each candidate for whom you wish to vote.
 

OR
    - You may pull the party lever, then turn up the pointer over the candidate or candidate's name of that party for whom you do not wish to vote and then turn down the pointer over the name of any other candidate for the same office for whom you do wish to vote.
 

OR
    - To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot labels push up the slide at the top of the machine for the office for which you wish to vote and write in the name of the person at your choice.
  - At the top of the machine above the names of the offices there are PROPOSED BOND QUESTIONS. Turn the small pointer down over either YES or NO. YES indicates a vote FOR the PROPOSED BOND QUESTIONS. NO indicates a vote AGAINST the PROPOSED BOND QUESTIONS.
  - Leave the pointers down for all persons for whom you wish to vote.
- REMEMBER: No votes are registered until "Red Handle" is moved to the left to open the curtain. Therefore, as long as the curtain is closed around you, you can change your vote as many times as you desire by simply turning up the pointer over the name of the candidate for whom you do not wish to vote, and turning down the pointer over the name of the candidate for the same office for whom you wish to vote. The machine will not allow you to vote for more than the proper number of candidates for each office.
- Move the Red Handle to the left. This will automatically register a vote for each of the candidates for whom you voted, and at the same time will turn back the voting pointers and open the curtain.
